#### **Parks**

- Cleaning Leaves/Sticks/Trash - Early Spring & Late Fall
- Park Trash Pick-up - especially parks on Hwy 51 (monthly)
- Landscaping in parks
- Weed Eating Parks
- Painting projects including pavilions, garbage cans, outdoor restrooms and inside of Park Center

#### **Special Projects**

- Helping at the Community Center, tasks include; helping cook meals, general maintenance and cleaning, providing activities for seniors.
- Assembling and maintaining Bluebird Houses
- Planting Trees around ball fields and the main entrance to the Park Center
- *Adopt-a-Park* Program – This program is for groups or companies that would select a park and agree to help maintain it once a month. Projects would include litter patrol, planting trees or flowers and repairs as needed. These groups would be recognized for their efforts similar to along highways.
- Assist Missouri Department of Conservation with planting and maintaining butterfly habitats.
- Paint murals either outside or inside of PPC or in the parks.
- Help assemble picnic tables Picnic Tables - August, 2016

- *Adopt-a-Flower Bed Program* - choose one or more of the flower beds in the City's park system to plant flowers and install and maintain landscaping. Similar options are available for city round-a-bouts, parking lots, City Hall, Police and Fire Departments.
- *Playground Equipment* - The City has plans for updating and modernizing our playgrounds and neighborhood parks. This will present opportunities for individuals to sponsor entire playgrounds or a particular piece of equipment on a new playground.
- *Shelters/Pavilions* - additional shelters/pavilions are needed at select locations throughout the park system. This would be a great opportunity for an Eagle Scout, construction company, or building/maintenance class to leave a lasting mark on the park system.
