

PAVILIONS AT CITY PARK

The City Park of Perryville is home to 6 pavilions – 2 large pavilions and 4 small pavilions. The following is a brief description of each pavilion.

Pavilion # 10

This large pavilion will accommodate approximately 150-200 people. Located in the heart of the City Park, this pavilion has 25 picnic tables and 3 handicapped accessible picnic tables, 2 barbeque grills, a water hydrant, 4 trash receptacles, lights, and electrical outlets. The Veterans Memorial Ball Field can be found nearby as well as bathrooms and a paved parking lot. There are 2 playground areas and 1 swing set area with safety surfaces for children to play and enjoy. The Disc Golf course starts next to this pavilion.

Pavilion # 20

This small pavilion is located on the south end of the City Park next to the T-ball Fields. This pavilion has a large gravel parking lot, a playground area for small children, 12 picnic tables, 1 barbeque grill, a water hydrant, 4 trash receptacles, lights, and 2 electrical outlets. Restrooms are located within a short walking distance. This pavilion can hold approximately 60-70 people.

Pavilion # 30

Pavilion # 30 is also a small pavilion and is located on the southwest end of the City Park. This pavilion sits across the road from Ball Field #8 and has a gravel parking lot. There are 12 picnic tables, 1 barbeque grill, a water hydrant, lights, and limited number of electrical outlets. Restrooms are located within a short walking distance. This pavilion will also accommodate 60-70 people.

Pavilion # 40

Pavilion # 40 is located behind the Perry Park Center, next to the tennis courts. This small pavilion has 10 picnic tables, 1 barbeque grill, 2 trash receptacles, a water hydrant, lights, and limited electrical outlets. A port-a-potty serves as the restroom. The parking lot has been recently paved and sits across the street from the pavilion. This pavilion will seat about 50 people comfortably.

Eagle Eye Pavilion

Eagle Eye Pavilion is located behind the Perry County Historical Museum next to the Perry Park Center. This small pavilion has 6 picnic tables, 1 barbeque grill, a water hydrant, 2 trash receptacles, lights, and limited electrical outlets. It is located next to an accessible handicapped playground. Parking for this area is connected with the Historical Museum parking area. This pavilion will seat about 30 people.

Veterans Memorial Pavilion

Veterans Memorial Pavilion sits in front of the Perry Park Center and overlooks Veteran Memorial Ball Field. This large pavilion has seating for 138 people. It has 22 octagon tables that will seat 6 people per table and 1 table that is handicapped accessible for 2 wheelchairs. There are 4 trash receptacles, a barbeque grill, water, and limited electrical outlets. Restrooms are located within a short walking distance.

PAVILIONS AT BANK OF MISSOURI SOCCER COMPLEX

The Bank of Missouri Soccer Complex has 4 Pavilions - 3 pavilions that can be reserved and 1 pavilion that can be used but not reserved. The following is a brief description of each pavilion

Optimist Soccer Pavilion

This Pavilion is located at the Concession Stand area at the Soccer Complex. There are 8 picnic tables, 1 barbeque grill, 3 trash receptacles, a bike rack, lights, limited electric, and bathrooms. A playground area is located within a short walking distance. This pavilion also has a large paved parking area. This pavilion will accommodate 50 people.

Since this pavilion is directly connected with the Concession Stand, it will not be able to be reserved during the Optimist Summer Camps, PHS Girls Spring Soccer Games, PHS Boys Fall Soccer Games, Mayfest Tournament, and the Fall Tournament.

Rotary Pavilion

This small Pavilion is the first pavilion as you enter the Soccer Complex off the 51 By-pass. It has 8 picnic tables, 2 trash receptacles, water, and limited electrical outlets. Bathrooms are located within a short walking distance as well as a playground area with a safety surface. A paved parking area is located in front of the pavilion. A multi-purpose court is within a short walking distant. This pavilion will accommodate 50 people.

Toohey Pavilion

This small Pavilion is located at the Soccer Complex next to a large paved parking area. There are 12 picnic tables, 4 trash cans, 1 large barbeque grill, water, lights, and electrical outlets. A new playground area with a safety surface can be found close by for children to play. The multi-purpose court is located next to this pavilion. New bathrooms are within a short walking distance. This pavilion will seat 60-70 people.

Zoellner Pavilion - Non-Rentable (No water or electric available)

This Pavilion is located at the backend of the Soccer Complex off Rand Street. It has 4 picnic tables and 2 trash receptacles. This pavilion would be ideal for a small picnic lunch.

PAVILION AT SPLASH PAD

Robert J. Miget Memorial Pavilion

This small pavilion by the Splash Pad has 3 tables, water and electric. Robert J. Miget Memorial Park is a beautiful 8.25-acre park located on the southeast border of Hwy. 51. The main feature of the Park is the splash pad, which opened in May 2019. This 4,200 square feet splash pad is the perfect place to spend a hot afternoon. With many water features and a dump bucket, it is fun for the whole family. Also new in 2019 is a 3-stall family restroom, perfect for young families. This park is an ideal place to take a lunch break with its pavilion and sitting areas, which is dedicated to our late Mayor, Robert "Bob" Miget.

The Splash Pad is not available to be reserved.
