

City of Perryville
Roll Out Trash Cart Policy

1. Every residential refuse account shall be issued one roll out trash cart, provided at no additional charge, by the City of Perryville. This cart shall be numbered and assigned to that specific address. Residents who lose possession of their cart will have another provided by the City of Perryville and an \$85 replacement fee shall be added to their next utility bill.
2. The assigned carts shall not be modified (e.g., lid removed), altered (e.g., holes drilled in the bottom) or otherwise damaged (e.g., painted for identification). Problems with the condition of individual carts shall be immediately reported to the Public Works Refuse Superintendent. Damage to carts may result in an \$85 replacement fee on resident's next utility bill.
3. All garbage must be placed in the assigned cart in order to be collected. Garbage bags, loose garbage, or garbage placed in other containers will not be collected. Carts may not be "shared" among multiple addresses.
4. Commercial pick-up will be limited to no more than two 96 gallon carts. The first cart will be free of charge, however, businesses that require a second cart, will pay a one-time fee of \$85 along with the prescribed monthly fee for service. Businesses that regularly exceed this limit are encouraged to contract with a commercial trash service. Garbage bags, loose garbage, or garbage placed in other containers will not be collected.
5. Residents unable to physically handle a trash cart due to terrain, medical reasons, or other special circumstances may contact the Refuse Superintendent or the Public Works Director to request an accommodation.
